

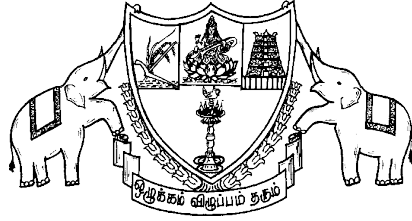

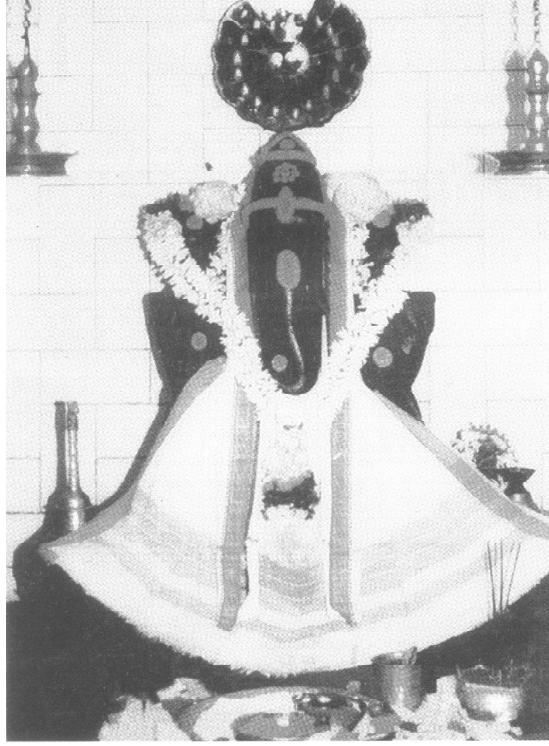

## **HISTORY OF THE COLLEGE**

The South Travancore Hindu College Association, with temple trusts and individuals as shareholders, was registered as a company on 9<sup>th</sup> January 1952 with a view to promoting the cause of higher education in South Travancore, now known as Kanyakumari District.

The College was granted affiliation on 14<sup>th</sup> March 1952 by the University of Travancore. On 7<sup>th</sup> April 1952, Sri. A.Ramaswamy Mudaliar, the Vice-Chancellor, laid the foundation stone, and on 11<sup>th</sup> July 1952, Sri. P.G.N.Unnithan, President, Travancore Devaswom Board, inaugurated the College at a special function, presided over by Kavimoni Sri. S. Desigavinayagam Pillai.

Started on a modest scale as an Intermediate College in 1952, the South Travancore Hindu College rapidly grew into a Degree College in 1955, and a Postgraduate College in 1956. With the reorganization of Indian States, the College first came to be affiliated to the University of Madras in 1957, then to Madurai Kamaraj University in 1966, and finally to Manonmaniam Sundaranar University in 1990.

Of the large number of individuals and institutions that have helped the College grow into its present status of being a Premier Institution, re-accredited with 'A' by the National Assessment and Accreditation Committee of the UGC, special mention must be made of the following:

## **SCHOLARSHIPS AND FEE CONCESSIONS**

Scholarships and fee concessions are awarded by the Government and other bodies to students of decided ability and to those who are unable to continue their studies without financial help on the basis of the results of the last examination passed.

### **1. Government of India Scholarships**

The Ministry of Education grants

- a) Scholarship for post-matriculation studies in Hindi to deserving students belonging to non-Hindi speaking States.
- b) Merit scholarship to children of primary and secondary school teachers for university education.

### **2. Harijan Welfare Department Scholarship**

Students belonging to Scheduled Castes, Scheduled Tribes, other eligible communities and Backward Classes including Most Backward Classes of Tamil Nadu, whose pecuniary circumstances are certified to be such as to prevent them from proceeding their studies without the assistance of scholarships are granted scholarship by the Harijan Welfare Department.

The annual income of the parent or guardian should not exceed Rs.2,00,000 for Backward Classes and minority communities and Rs.2,50,000 for S.C. students.

### **3. Indira Gandhi National Scholarship**

Indira Gandhi National Scholarship for Single Girl Child Awarded to PG girl students who are single child to their parents.

#### **4. Merit Scholarship**

Scholarships are awarded to deserving students by the Director of Collegiate Education, Chennai on the basis of the marks obtained by them at the previous examination.

#### **5. Scholarships to Children of Political Sufferers**

Residential and Non-residential Scholarships for students in Arts and Training Colleges are awarded by the Director of Collegiate Education to the children, step-children and grand-children by predeceased sons of political sufferers and children of persons who participated in the INA Movement studying in degree classes. The entire annual income of the family of the political sufferer or the guardian including that of the applicant from all sources should not exceed Rs.3,600.

Note: Post-graduate students are not eligible for this scholarship.

#### **6. Thiruppanandal Adheenam Scholarship (Special Awards)**

Five special awards to the value of Rs.200/- per student are given to poor Hindu students selected for their proficiency in the study and recital of “Kandar Kalivenba”.

#### **7. Thiruvavaduthurai Adheenam Scholarship**

Thiruvavaduthurai Adheenam education scholarship for UG and PG Tamil degree (each one) for students who do not avail any other scholarship and the students for this scholarship shall be selected by the College and the Adheenam.

#### **8. Students Aid Fund**

The object of this fund is to render financial assistance to poor students to meet their expenses towards education.

#### **9. Fee Concession**

a) Girl students (P.G) are eligible for full fee concession of tuition fee from the Government provided that the annual income of the parent or guardian of the student does not exceed Rs.50,000.

b) Students belonging to Most Backward Classes and Denotified Communities who are undergoing Degree Courses are exempted from

payment of tuition fee and special fees irrespective of the income of their parents. Fees will be deducted from the scholarship amount.

Note : The aids are tenable for three years in the case of the Degree Course and two years in the case of the Post-graduate Course students subject to the following conditions.

a) Scholarship holders shall show uniformly good progress throughout the course. If they score less than the required minimum marks in any group in any of the college examinations or tests, the aid shall be cancelled.

b) They shall continue to stay in this institution till the end of the course. In the event of their not completing the course, they shall refund such portion of the aid as they have received.

c) Their conduct and character must be good.

d) They shall put in not less than 90% attendance in classes.

## **IDENTITY CARD**

Every student must be in possession of the identity card during college hours and produce it on demand by any member of the staff.

## ATTENDANCE AND LEAVE OF ABSENCE

1. Every student shall attend the college regularly and punctually on all working days.
2. Attendance will be marked at the beginning of each period.
3. A student who is not in class when attendance is marked shall lose attendance for the session.
4. A student shall attend at least 75 percent of the lecture and practical classes in any subject, as well as the **Physical Training Classes/ NCC parades/NSS work etc.** in each semester.
5. No student shall absent himself/herself from the college without leave application. In case of sickness for more than three days, it must be accompanied by a Medical Certificate.
6. Application for leave in the prescribed form countersigned by the parent or guardian must be submitted to the Principal through the Group Tutor in advance of the date on which leave is desired. On absence due to unforeseen causes, an application for leave must be submitted as soon as possible, in no case later than the first day of return to college.
6. **75% of attendance is compulsory for getting free Laptop supplied by Government.**
7. Applications of leave for students residing in the hostel must be countersigned by the Deputy Warden.

8. A student absenting himself/herself from college for more than fifteen consecutive working days without satisfactory explanation is liable to have his/her name struck off the rolls.

## **COLLEGE EXAMINATIONS**

1. There shall be one Model Examination during each semester to assess the progress of students.
2. Absentees of the Model Examinations will be fined as per the decision of the college council.
3. A student will be permitted to take the University Examination only if he/she,
  - a) earns the necessary attendance in classes (75%)
  - b) attends all the practical classes and submits records.
  - c) takes all the tests
  - d) does the assignments
  - e) bears good conduct and character
4. Students who fail to show satisfactory progress during the academic year or fail to put in 60% attendance shall be required to repeat the whole semester in an affiliated college before taking the University Examination. Those securing 61% and above attendance may be granted permission subject to the conditions prescribed by the University.

## **MEDICAL EXAMINATION**

1. Every newly admitted student will be medically examined by a qualified doctor.
2. Students found to have defect or disease must undergo treatment at their own expenses and submit the result thereof to the college office signed by the Medical Officer.

## **CERTIFICATES**

### **Term Certificate**

Term Certificate shall not be granted to students unless they show satisfactory progress during the year by their regularity in attendance, diligent application to work and securing of required percentage of marks in the various tests.

### **Conduct Certificate**

Conduct Certificates will be issued to students, usually at the end of their course of study on the basis of H.O.D's report.

### **Sports and Games Certificate**

Only those students who evince keen interest in athletics and games by regular participation are eligible to receive certificates at the end of their course.

College team players and Intramural Sports and Tournament winners and runners up will be awarded merit certificates.

### **Other Certificates**

1. Applications for certificates-Transfer, Conduct, Course and Date of Birth - must be made in the prescribed form and will be received in the office on all working days between 9.30 a.m. and 12 Noon. The certificates applied for will be issued 24 hours after the receipt of application, on the production of identity card.
2. A fee of Re.1 shall be charged for issuing each of the following :
  - a) Conduct Certificate
  - b) Course Certificate
  - c) Certificate of age
3. A late fee of Rs.3 will be charged, if the student applies for Transfer Certificate ten days after the receipt of the mark statement from the university.
4. Certificates will not be issued to students who are in arrears of fees, etc., or to those from whom library books are due.
5. A student applying for any certificate by post must enclose stamps to cover the postage for sending it to his/her address by registered post.
6. A student who leaves the college before completing the course without the written permission of the principal is not eligible to get any certificate.

### **FEE COLLECTION**

1. Fee will be collected on all working days between 9.30 a.m and 3 p.m. Absence with or without leave from the college shall not be an excuse for nonpayment of fees at the proper time.



2. Students failing to pay the fees within 10 days from the reopening of the college shall have to pay fine at the rate of Rs.1/- per day of default. If the fee is not paid before the end of the month, the student's name shall be struck off the rolls. If readmitted, he/she shall, in addition to fees and fines due from him/her, pay a readmission fee of Rs.5.
3. All receipts must be preserved and produced when called upon to do so.
4. The fees schedule is shown in the tables on pages 50-53.
5. The fees for the year will be collected as follows ;

In two instalments payable within ten working days from the date of reopening of each semester.

6. Tuition fee alone will be refundable as per rule in force.
7. All certificates pertaining to a student will be issued only after his/her fees arrears are cleared.

**Other fees :**

1. Each newly enrolled student shall pay an admission fee of Rs.5.
2. Students who have passed Higher Secondary Examination will have to pay Rs.200 as University Entrance Fee & Recognition Fee and Rs.50 as Certificate Verification Fee.
3. Fee for transmission to the University.  
Students from Universities other than M.S.University will have to apply for recognition of examination passed by paying Rs.200 each along with the first instalment of fees to be remitted to the Manonmaniam Sundaranar University. They must also submit,
  - a) Original or Provisional Degree Certificate and Mark Sheet in the case of P.G. students and Pass Certificate and Mark Sheet of the qualifying examination in the case of U.G. students.
  - b) A course certificate from the Principal of the college last studied for having undergone the prescribed course of study.

## **LIBRARY AND READING ROOM**

The college has a good library of books covering a variety of subjects which the students are expected to make good use of.

### **LIBRARY RULES**

1. All students and members of the teaching and non-teaching staff are members of the library.
2. The library and reading-room will be kept open on all working days from 8.30 a.m. to 4 p.m.
3. Each UG student will be issued 2 library tickets and PG & M.Phil student will be issued 6 library tickets at a time.
4. A student requiring a book should fill in a Library Call Slip (to be had from the book stall) and post it in the Call Slip Box in between 8.30 a.m. and 2 p.m.
5. Books will be issued to student members only on production of their Identity Card and the library ticket.
6. In case the ID card is lost, the librarian should be informed immediately, failing which the owner of the card will be held responsible for the books issued on presentation of the lost ID card.
7. Borrowers are responsible for loss or damage to the books borrowed. The date slip (on page 2 of the cover of each book) and the number label should not be tampered with. Serious notice shall be taken of any violation of this rule. Every book will be examined as soon as it is returned and if any book is found to be marked, soiled or damaged, the borrower shall be required to replace the book with a new copy or pay such compensation as may be fixed by the Principal.
8. Borrowers on receiving books shall examine them before they leave the library and report to the Librarian any damage, if noticed.
9. Borrowers shall on no account sub-lend books to others.

10. A student is entitled to keep a book for a week and a member of the Staff for a month from the date of issue. Every book borrowed from the library shall be returned on the due date (marked on the date slip) before 2 p.m. It may be reissued only once to the same person for a further period of one week, but under a new call slip.
11. If books are not returned to the library on the due date, a fine of 25 paise per book per day shall be levied. The library ticket will be returned to the borrower only on payment of the fine. Absence from the college shall not be an excuse for any delay in returning the books.
12. Books due on a holiday shall be returned without fine on the next working day.
13. Books for vacation (except summer vacation) reading will be issued only in the last week of the odd semester and they should be returned within the first three working days of the succeeding semester.
14. Reference Books and bound copies of University Examination question papers shall not be lent out.
15. The Librarian may recall any book at any time even if the normal period of loan has not expired.
16. Students who leave the College for any reason in the middle of the semester should return the books before they leave the college.
17. Members are prohibited from taking their private belongings with them in to the reading-room.
18. The Librarian may refuse to issue books to those who violate these rules.
19. No reading material shall be removed from its place in the reading-room without the knowledge of the Librarian.
20. Members are requested to handle all magazines and journals with care. They shall be liable to make good the loss or damage, if any, done to periodicals.

21. Loose copies of magazines shall not be let out.
22. Strict silence should be maintained in the reading room. Mobile phones should be switched off in the library premises. No discussion is allowed inside the library.
23. Library books will be issued to students from 8 a.m. to 2 p.m.

### **INTERNET CENTRE**

A separate Internet Centre with 25 computers provides internet service to the students. The Internet Centre is kept open on all working days.

### **STUDY & INFORMATION CENTRES**

The college has been functioning as a study centre for the Indira Gandhi National Open University (IGNOU) and as an Information Centre for Manonmaniam Sundaranar University and Tamil Nadu Open University (TNOU).

### **HINDECON RESEARCH CENTRE**

Hindecon is the research wing of the P.G. Department of Economics. The Centre is funded by four Endowments.

### **Code of Conduct**

Lectures and meetings shall be arranged only with the consent of the President, the Vice - President and the Principal.

No intimation or report shall be sent to the press by the Secretaries or other office-bearers without the written permission of the Principal who is the ultimate authority on all matters connected with the Associations.
